File 4 – Tax Records, copy into 2-3 pp. (of Fredrick Mathews and Addison Pavey, 1838-1869.

File 5 – Receipts & Accounts, pp. unknown—late 1700's

File 6 – Poll/Account Book, 2 items.

File 7 – Deeds, Mortgages & Leases, 35 items—late 1700's-1800's.

File 8 – Photographs & Post Cards, 11 items—early 1900's.

File 9 – Butler, Echols, Hendrick, and Slaughter, 37 pp. (wills, family group sheets, correspondence, and notes)
