Scope and Content Note:

The Esther Dillon Marsh Collection is a collection of genealogical information comprised of not only family group sheets, but also extensive copies of records dating to the Revolutionary War. Also present are many death certificates, pension records from the Civil War, and copies of military records

dating to the Revolutionary War as well. The main surnames located within this collection are Chapman, Dillon, Green, Lockwood, Paxson, Purdy and Yarrington. This collection was compiled by Esther Dillon Marsh in a time period covering roughly 1977 through 2010. The collection covers Massachusetts during the Colonial Era, Pennsylvania, and central Ohio in the Union County area. Many of the ancestors of Esther Dillon Marsh were active in early colonial times and served with distinction in service to the United States.

The collection was donated by Elaine Marsh, daughter of Esther Dillon Marsh of Hilliard, Ohio.
