File 1- Marker family of Darke Co. (OH): records from Christian Cemetery (Adams Township), record of 1850 Iowa census, family groups sheets

File 2- Gladys Smiley papers: Gladys Smiley of Lima, OH, ancestral charts, Family group sheets, will, family history, family photos of Gladys

File 3- Pe-aitch-ta (PHT): history of an American Indian, the Waltons, and the Rev. George Mitchell family

File 4- Miscellaneous military papers: various military discharge papers, papers detailing military records
