### **Scope & Content:**

The Antiquarian Club of Mansfield in Richland Co OH was organized at the YWCA in Mansfield in September 1961 and was originally called the “Y Antiquarian Club”. Initial organizers were: Peg Epps, Ruth Fisher Hauenstein, Frances Kehoe, Lois Oakes, Loren Maglott, Martha Patterson, Harold McCuen and the YWCA staff. Their motto: “The Joy of Yesterday can

be Found in our Memories Today.” In 1964, association with the YWCA was dropped and the group became the Antiquarian Club meeting at Kingwood Center on the first Tuesday of each month. Several OGS members were active with the Antiquarians including Kaye Yarman, Mary Jane Henney, Lucille Brumenshenkel, Donna Urban, and certainly others. The final meeting of the group was held at the home of Virgil and Shirley Addlesperger in Lexington, Ohio, on 7 Jun 1989. This collection is a fairly complete group of minutes, newspaper stories, membership lists, and records of the club.
