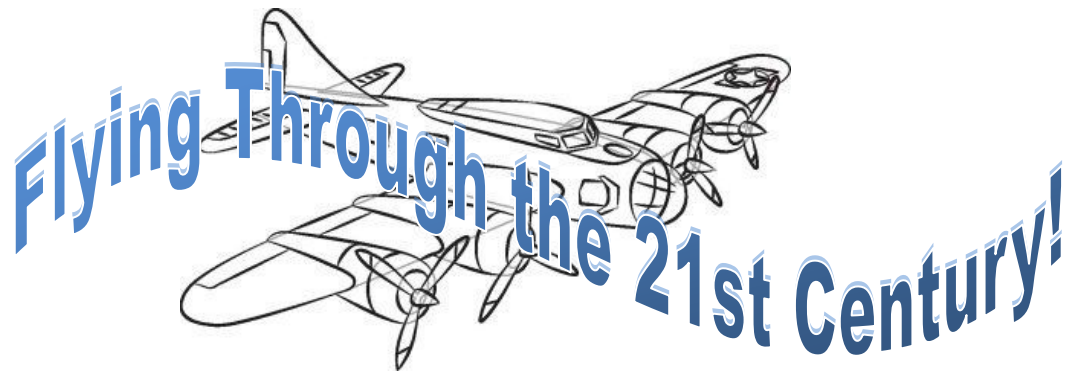


# 16th Annual OGS Genealogy Librarians' Seminar
