Scope and Content: This collection is the life work of Marvin Ryan of La Mesa, California. It documents his branch of the Ryan family from their emigration from Ireland, mostly in the 18th and 19th Centuries, up to 1981, when the creator passed away. Major areas covered are Knox and Coshocton Counties in Ohio and Schuyler County, Illinois.

System of Arrangement: Each file folder is marked at the top with the pages it contains. Folders 1 - 11 are pages 1 - 899 in sequence. Folders 12 - 14 contain the remaining 202 pages, overlapping the contents of the others. At the beginning of folder 1 is a "table of contents," showing groups of pages and what each group contains.
