Scope and Content: This collection on the Link family centers mainly on Jacob Link (ca. 1739-1780), a Revolutionary War veteran. Link was a Frontier Ranger from southwest Pennsylvania who was killed in August 1780 near Wheeling, West Virginia. There is also estate material on a Jacob Link who died 1843 in Seneca Co., Ohio. His wife was Mary Ann Gering Link. Other records, such as marriage certificates, wills, and military records are included in this collection as well as the private correspondence of Jane A. Morris in her research efforts.

Extent: approximately 150 pages; 1 file.
