The clippings include a photograph of the farmer (taken at the time of article’s writing), a short biography about the farmer, and the location of his farm. This collection also contains five obituaries and one commemorative article on other Shelby area residents.

System of Arrangement: Clippings are in alphabetical order by farmer’s surname. Obituaries and other clippings are filed after the “Shelby Famers” column.
