Biography of Creator: Adelaide L. “Della” Schlienger (15 Apr 1884-5 May 1982) was the only daughter of Joseph C. Schlienger (c. 1869-14 Feb 1942) and Emelia Freitag (1874-1895). She married Burton Garfield Ames (1880-1953) on June 7, 1911. They had one daughter, Helen Marguerite Ames (13 Feb 1913-20 July 1913). Burton was the son of Samuel Ames (1831-1893) & Amelia Merriam (1845-1908).

Scope and Content: This is a scrapbook of newspaper clippings from North Olmsted and the great west-side of Cleveland area as clipped between 1887-1956 and glued into a scrapbook album. Most of the clippings are about local people or events including many obituaries, wedding anniversaries, marriages, family and school reunions, births, and deaths. The headings of locations include: “Olmsted”; “Rockport” (Lakewood); “Dover” (Westlake); “Butternut Ridge” (North Olmsted); “Berea”; and others. Some of the content appears to be of the Freitag/Schlienger family and others of the Merriam/Ames family in addition to other friends, neighbors, and acquaintances.
