Biography of Creator:

Barbara Ann McBride, 87, of Mansfield passed away on January 11, 2023. Her husband, Dan, had passed away suddenly just weeks before. Barbara was born in Mansfield on July 23, 1935 to Floyd Arthur and Ella Catherine "Katie" (Anders) Huff. Barbara graduated from Mansfield Senior High School in 1953. She then attended Kent State University for a short time, where she became a member of Alpha Xi Delta sorority. She subsequently transferred to Ashland College where she received her Bachelor's degree in Education in 1958. Barbara met Dan while they were students at Ashland College. Dan fell "head over heels" in love with this bright redheaded girl. They married in 1957 while they were still students and that love lasted for 65 years of marriage. They raised three sons, David, Mark, and Michael who were the center of their lives. They had two grandsons, Baker and Miles, who they couldn't have loved more. Barbara and Dan loved their cottage at Pleasant Hill. So many peaceful hours they spent together enjoying the woods, lake, and each other. They also loved taking long drives through the countryside enjoying nature. After Barbara and Dan retired, they traveled extensively over the United States and enjoyed cruises to the Caribbean and Alaska. Barbara also traveled to Germany, Italy, and Russia with friends. Barbara loved her friends and family. Michael, their third son, died in 2002 which was devastating. But thankfully they had sons David and Mark, who were always to be

loved forever. David and Michael graduated from Ohio State University and Mark from North Central State College. Barbara also considered herself lucky to have the special friends and neighbors, the Berick family, in her life. Barbara's "faith journey" took her in many different directions over many years. She took advantage of numerous opportunities for spiritual enrichment. She became a member of the First Congregation Church where Dan and she were married and have been members since 1956. Barbara participated in countless committees and activities through the church and especially appreciated the outstanding music programs presented there. Barbara taught elementary school at Creveling, Carpenter, and Newman schools in Mansfield. While at Newman School, Barbara was the recipient of a Martha Holden Jennings scholarship. She retired from Newman School where she loved to teach and loved the staff and children. Barbara had an insatiable appetite for knowledge and pursued it through many different venues. During her years as a teacher, she would get up at 5:00a.m. to take graduate level courses over the television. In later life, she attended a number of advanced courses through the 60's Plus Program at OSU Mansfield campus. Barbara loved classical music and visiting art museums. She spent many hours on the computer and at the Ohio Genealogy Library researching her family history and origins. An early and enthusiastic environmentalist, she started P.Y.E. (Protect Your Environment) along with an OSU professor and marched in protests to the building of nuclear power plants in Ohio. She also participated in a protest march with Senator Sherrod Brown.

In addition to her parents, Barbara was preceded in death by her husband, Dan, son, Michael Robert, and her brother, Robert Eugene. She is survived by her sons, David and Mark, grandsons, Baker and Miles McBride, close cousins, Gary Hunt and Vickie (Hunt) O'Hara. Barbara and Dan decided ahead of time, that when both were deceased, they would have a combined memorial service. There will be a gathering of family and friends on Saturday, February 11, 2023 at 2:00-3:00 pm with service at 3:00 at Wappner Funeral Directors-Ontario, 100 S. Lexington Springmill Road. Custodial History: After Barbara was moved to a care center in Ashland in May 2021, her husband Dan gave 7 Home Depot small-size moving boxes of material to Sunda Peters with the intention of it going to the Ohio Genealogical Society.

Scope and Content: This collection is narrowly focused on Barbara's paternal grandmother's family line from the Price, Emerson, and Boynton families. Each family file contains a few original documents, related clippings, and ephemera, as well as 4 large cabinet photo albums of mostly all-named individuals.

System of Arrangement: Files in alphabetical order by surname.

Extent: 3.59 linear feet; Two file boxes and two oversize photo boxes.

Access: No access restrictions.

Physical/Technical Access: File 43 Huff-McBride Wedding recording is on a reel-to-reel magnetic tape. OGS currently does not have equipment available to access the content of this tape.

Language: English

Provenance: Barbara Ann Huff McBride inherited the old photo albums from her father, Floyd Arthur Huff, who had inherited them from his mother Iva Mae Price Huff, who had inherited them from her mother Carrie Emerson Price. The other material was created by Barbara herself during her lifetime. The collection was donated to OGS by Sunda Anderson Peters in 2023.

Related Archival Materials: A collection of real photo postcards from Licking County locations in Concord; Liberty Township; Johnstown; Alexandria, etc. was moved to the Ohio Photograph Collection.

Processing Information: Collection was heavily weeded and reorganized by processor.

Descendants of Steven Emerson (1782-1856) of Weare, Hillsboro County, New Hampshire and Elisabeth Boynton (1780-1854) of Andover, Massachusetts who were married in 1803 and settled in Concord, Liberty Township, Licking County, Ohio. Includes birth records for Steven and his siblings Hannah Emerson (1779), Molly Emerson (1775), Lydia Emerson (1771), James Emerson (1767), Susanna Emerson (1763), and Moses Emerson (1760).

4 pages of handwritten notes telling the story of John Langden Emerson (1821-1900) and how they came from New Hampshire to Ohio.

File 5: Emerson Family – Lee Hannahs Letters

Lee Lenn Hannahs (1914-1981) did extensive research on the Emerson family as well as the settlement of Concord in Liberty Township, Licking County. This file contains copies of letters he distributed to cousins in the 1960s and 1970s including his own memories, interviews with family members, research he had done at courthouses, cemeteries, libraries, etc. His father was Fred M. Hannahs (1889-1975); grandmother Mable Emma "May" (Emerson) Hannahs (1859-1945) and great-grandfather James Monroe "Roe" Emerson (1817-1884). James Monroe Emerson and John Langden Emerson, great-great-grandfather of Barbara Huff McBride were brothers. This file contains a great deal of primary sourced information about the Emerson family which cannot be found in any other source.

Stephen Emerson served as a Lieutenant in the 2nd Regiment (Steele's) of the New Hampshire Militia during the war of 1812. These are his service records as obtained from the National Archives. He is the GGGG grandfather of Barbara Huff McBride.

OBITUARY:

Daniel Dean McBride died October 30, 2022.

Dan was born in Ashland on February 23, 1936, to John and Eleanor Hart McBride. Dan graduated from Ashland High School in 1954 and Ashland College in 1958. Dan was a two-time All American football player at Ashland College and inducted into the Ashland College and Ashland County Hall of Fame.

Dan was a teacher in Mansfield City Schools for 32 years, primarily teaching comparative government at Mansfield Senior High School. He also worked as an electrician for B & M Electric, alongside his life-long friend, George Berick. Dan was appointed an Honorary Deacon at the First Congregational Church and was an active member since 1956. Dan loved working at his cottage at Pleasant Hill Lake and was extremely handy, completing many projects there and at his church.

Dan is survived by his wife of 64 years, Barbara Huff McBride whom he married in 1957. He was the father of three children David, Mark, and Michael (deceased). He was Granddaddy to Baker and Miles.

OBITUARY:

Michael Robert McBride, 32, of 3535 Ivy Hill Circle, Cortland, Ohio died unexpectedly Saturday, October 19, 2002 in Warren, Ohio, succumbing to the demons of his six-year cocaine addiction.

Michael was born December 28, 1969 in Mansfield, Ohio to Daniel Dean and Barbara Ann (Huff) McBride. He was a lifelong resident of Mansfield and was baptized and confirmed at the First Congregational Church. Michael graduated from Mansfield Senior High School in 1988, where he ran track. As a member of the Linden Pool swim team, he won many trophies in freestyle events. He always enjoyed music and played drums in his youth.

Michael graduated from The Ohio State University in 1993 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Elementary Education. For 2 years (1993-1995) he taught 5th & 6th grade at Sacred Heart Catholic School, Bethlehem. Michael and his brother, David, especially enjoyed traveling and visited many countries around the world. He was an avid Ohio State Buckeye fan and an enthusiastic follower of the Cleveland Browns and Indians. Michael enjoyed a relationship with a close circle of friends from early childhood to the present.

Family and friends will always remember Michael's fun-loving and gentle nature, as well as his sensitive spirit. His smile lit up the hearts of the many who loved him.

Besides his parents, Michael is survived by his brothers and sisters-in-law, David Dean and Lisa (Adams) McBride of Columbus, Ohio and Mark Franklin and Suzy (Mock) McBride; nephews, Baker and Miles McBride of Mansfield; and special friend, Kristi Dye of Warren, Ohio, who stood by him.
